Secretaries Report for AGM 2020.

Reflecting on the past year, apart from dealing the fallout from the Coronavirus, I believe this has been a successful year for our club. This is not just on court, but also increasing our membership numbers, improving communication with our members, developing our website, carrying out required maintenance and refurbishment to our club house. Progress over the year is as follows:

Online Annual Membership form

An online membership form with straight through payment process has been implemented on our website (hidden until after Coronavirus impact). This is an easy way to progress membership selection/payment and streamlines our administration process.

Junior Tennis

We had a low number of juniors attending the Saturday morning tennis sessions. To address this the committee organised a couple of successful open days to promote junior tennis to the local schools, scouts groups, etc.

We held 6 week free junior tennis sessions back in February/March and as a result we are pleased to advise our number of juniors has increased Junior fees used to pay 75% of the cost for 2 of our juniors (Archie & Aidan) to train as LTA level 1 assistance tennis coaches. I am pleased to advise they are both now qualified and have been assisting with the Saturday tennis.

Badminton

Over the second half of the year we have been attempting to ensure representation from badminton on the committee This is now in place and we will be focusing on increasing use of the badminton courts and dealing with any issues raised by the badminton members.

Maintenance

We are due to encounter out of plan expense to replace our boundary wood fence and fix

our chain link fence, resulting in recent high winds.

Plenty of maintenance work was carried out this year by our committee members, volunteer tennis and badminton members. Some of the highlights include: Transforming the garden area at the back of the clubhouse, in support of the Davis Cup

visit.

Fixing the roof over both badminton courts.

A fantastic effort of volunteers to refurbish both Badminton Courts.

Creation of a new meeting room.

Our Chairman was able to secure for no charge enough paint for both badminton courts

and lobby/walk way areas of the clubhouse.

On behalf of the committee I would like to thank all our members for the time and

support provided during this maintenance work.

Fund raising

Social Media

We now have a social media coordinator on the committee who will focus on creating awareness of the club facilities and provide awareness of planned open days and social events.

Treasurer's Report AGM 2020.

The club made a profit of £3,108 in 2019, which represents an increase of £907 over the 2018 period. This was achieved despite facing falling income from the previous year, and was largely due to reduced costs resulting from the generous efforts of volunteers in undertaking maintenance and improvement works, without which the club's expenditure would have been significantly higher.

As you can see from the Profit and Loss account, income from tennis subscriptions and direct badminton subscriptions has increased, whilst badminton club rental,

court hire and visitors' fees have all decreased from compared to the previous year. The income from Summer Camp and a property insurance claim in 2018 was not repeated in the 2019 period. On a positive note, the clubs commitment to open days and club fundraising has been successful, with other income significantly increased during 2019.

Overall expenditure has fallen by £1,858 (adjusted for the one-off Defibrillator purchased in 2018) compared to the previous period, despite £600 being spent on court refurbishment this year. The largest single reduction was £1,687 in repairs and maintenance, which as stated above, was due to the efforts of a number of kind volunteers. Whilst website expenditure was minimal for 2019, the committee has decided to invest in significantly upgrading the website to provide improved information and to enable on-line payments for the 2020 period.

The committee wishes to retain and increase its current membership, and therefore fees remain at a low level compared to many other clubs. After careful consideration, a small increase in fees to keep pace with inflation is proposed this year.
